'Heutinck' is a more compact variety than other Acanthus. Glossy, green, lobed leaves. Flowers tubular. It was also selected because of its pink with white flowers. This combines beautifully with the purple flower bracts. 'Heutinck' is winter hardy, drought-tolerant (once established) and bee-friendly. Very suitable for xeriscaping.
